## Timber frame workshop with Jack Sobon

Are you interested in going to a timber frame with one of the world's best teachers, Jack Sobon? Then you have the opportunity to join for a week in May 2018 at the Jamtli Museum, Östersund, Sweden.



### About Jamtli

Jamtli museum in Östersund started in 1912 and for over 100 years we have created a fantastic environment for the whole family. We are also starting our course activities seriously, focusing on traditional crafts and house construction in modern times. We have 110 buildings of which 80 are cultural history houses, the oldest dating from the 16th century. These houses are our course items!

### Why Timber Frame?

Timber frame is a great way to build a body, a climate-smart way that gives healthy houses and people, with little imprints in nature. The tradition is worldwide, dating back in Sweden from the 17th century. A fancy thing is that you can produce all parts of the body yourself for a long period of time, then assemble it alone or preferably with friends and raise it on a day.

### The project on Jamtli

We will build a larger porch with American twist, on our lodge, located at our grand stage. The lodge is currently rented to different arrangements and is used for our own arrangements. On the veranda there is a fireplace, a baking oven and the porch equipped with tables and chairs etc. The oven is also built at a parallel workshop! A third workshop in smithing and produces details to the porch. The workshop takes up to 20 people and we have evening arrangements, mingling and an excursion. All participants and instructors from 3 workshops participate in all evening activities, which is a very good forum for networking and experience sharing! We also hope that some or all participants want to present an interesting project they work with or have worked with. You do not need any previous knowledge but it's good if you done some woodwork before.



## Jack Sobon

Jack is probably one of the world's best teachers of Timber Frame, with a number of books in his luggage, 50-ish courses in several parts of the world, and he is also a great educator and storyteller.

## You need:

Hand saw 22-24" long crosscut and, moreover, a splitting saw, but no requirement.

Measuringtape, inch, 25 feet would be great

Chisels for Timber frame 1½ and 2"

Combinationsquare with inches

Mallet- preferably with rawhide

Framingsquare in inches

There are: Drilling machines, Bourneman layout template and some tools that can be borrowed.

We work exclusively with hand tools, partly because it's less harmful, one hear each other and does not have to trip over cables, and you'll hear easily when Jack wants to tell who's going to get "The Frog" (nothing to strive for)!
